The 2019 IEEE Power and Energy Conference at Illinois (PECI) will be held February 28-March 1st, 2019 at the University of Illinois in Champaign, IL. Peci offers students two full days of networking opportunities with members of the power and energy community from industry (e.g. ComEd, Ameren, etc.), national laboratories (e.g. Sandia National Lab, NREL, etc.), and academia.

The Peci committee is pleased to announce that they have secured NSF funding to cover conference registration (including 6 meals) and a shared hotel room for two nights for a limited number of non-author students attending from U.S. schools.

The committee has some remaining scholarships available, so we invite students to submit a scholarship application located here.

In addition to technical paper presentations, Peci 2019 will include four keynote sessions, two tutorials, and a panel discussion. PECI 2019 will also feature an expanded poster session in which researchers can present their work and exchange ideas with conference attendees from both industry and academia. As in previous years, poster presentation does not require the submission of a publication, and best poster awards will be presented.
