Submission due date: Continuous submissions until 31 March 2021

The IEEE IAS Most Happening Chapter Contest Purpose:

The purpose of this contest is to recognize the IAS chapters that have been continuously organizing and hosting various events and activities throughout the past year. Chapters are evaluated based on the number of online submissions done by the chapter during the past year and the quality and diversity of the events hosted by the chapters.

Eligibility:

Any active IAS Chapter can make submissions. Submissions are allocated based on the specific chapter which held the event.

Nomination and Selection Procedure:

To enter the contest, the chapter has to make submissions about their activities using the IAS CMD NEWSLETTER Website (link: <http://sites.ieee.org/ias-cmd/861-2/submit-an-activity/>), throughout the year continuously. For the 2021 contest, the articles about activities that happened from the period 15th March 2020 until 31st March 2021 will be considered.

Selection Criteria:

Winning chapters are selected based on the following criteria:

- Number of articles submitted
- Number of selected articles published
- Activities/events mentioned in the published articles
- Quality of the events
- Regularity of submissions
